Holidays on the Hill Schedule of Events

Circle of Trees – November 23: Families and neighbors are invited to gather at the Woodmere Art Museum (9201 Germantown Avenue) on November 23 for the annual Circle of Trees celebration. The free festivities begin at 5:30 p.m., where guests can indulge in hot chocolate, cider, and cookies while enjoying festive music and goodie bags for the kids. Santa himself will make a grand entrance, arriving on a charming antique fire truck, adding extra magic to the evening. Together, visitors can count down to the lighting of the Art Museum and surrounding trees. Families are encouraged to bring a new unwrapped toy or a new, gently used book to donate to a school-aged child.

Holiday Garden Railway – November 23 through December 30: The Holiday Garden Railway at Morris Arboretum & Gardens (100 E. Northwestern Avenue) returns November 23 and continues daily from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. through December 30. Visitors can view the enchanting rail cars and intricately decorated villages, which span over a third of a mile track surrounded by a festive wonderland of lights and sounds.
